LEEN 56 A production power trimaran

EEL Trimarans, born in 2009, can claim to be the only manufacturer to offer large production trimarans - 30 units are produced every year. Thanks to this unique positioning and their expertise, the yard announced the launch of a new brand of powered trimarans called Leen (an intelligent reflection of Neel, being named after the owner and founder of the yard, Eric Bruneel). The first model, launched back in April, is the Leen 56, a powertri characterized by a platform of large surface-area, topped by an imposing flybridge. The advantage of these new oceangoing multihulls is their very low drag: consumption will be limited to 2 liters (just over ½ US gal) per mile at cruising speed (12 knots). The diesel engine in the central hull will be supported by two electric pods - one in each hull - to facilitate maneuvering in port and for leaving an anchorage with the greatest discretion.
